












Our commitments have grown sharply in Asia, but Africa remains a priority for AFD in this sector.

Climate and gender equality: core aspects of our projects





also benefit the climate, representing a contribution of more than €786 M, through actions involving adaptation to the effects of climate change and mitigation of greenhouse gas emissions

Projects with impact on the ground

The AFD-financed projects that were in progress or completed in 2022 enabled the following:



20.700hectares of agricultural land started their conversion to agroecological systems

363,000 family farms

saw their economic performance improve or met the conditions to achieve it

90,700 family farms

were supported in their conversion to agroecological systems

935,500

people were empowered through improved access to services in the agricultural sector

Projects with impact on the ground

The AFD-financed projects that were in progress or completed in 2022 also enabled the following:
