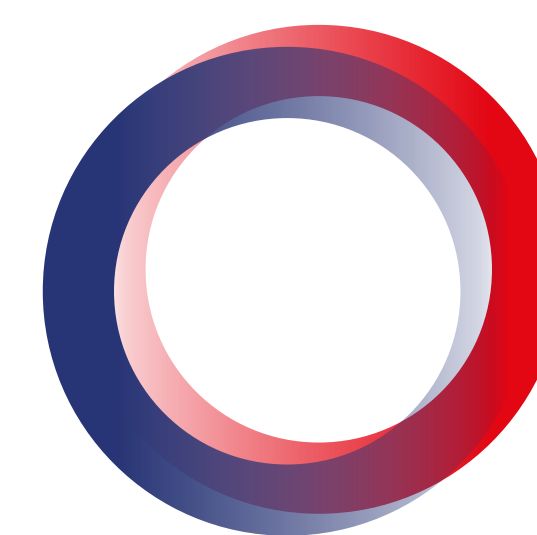


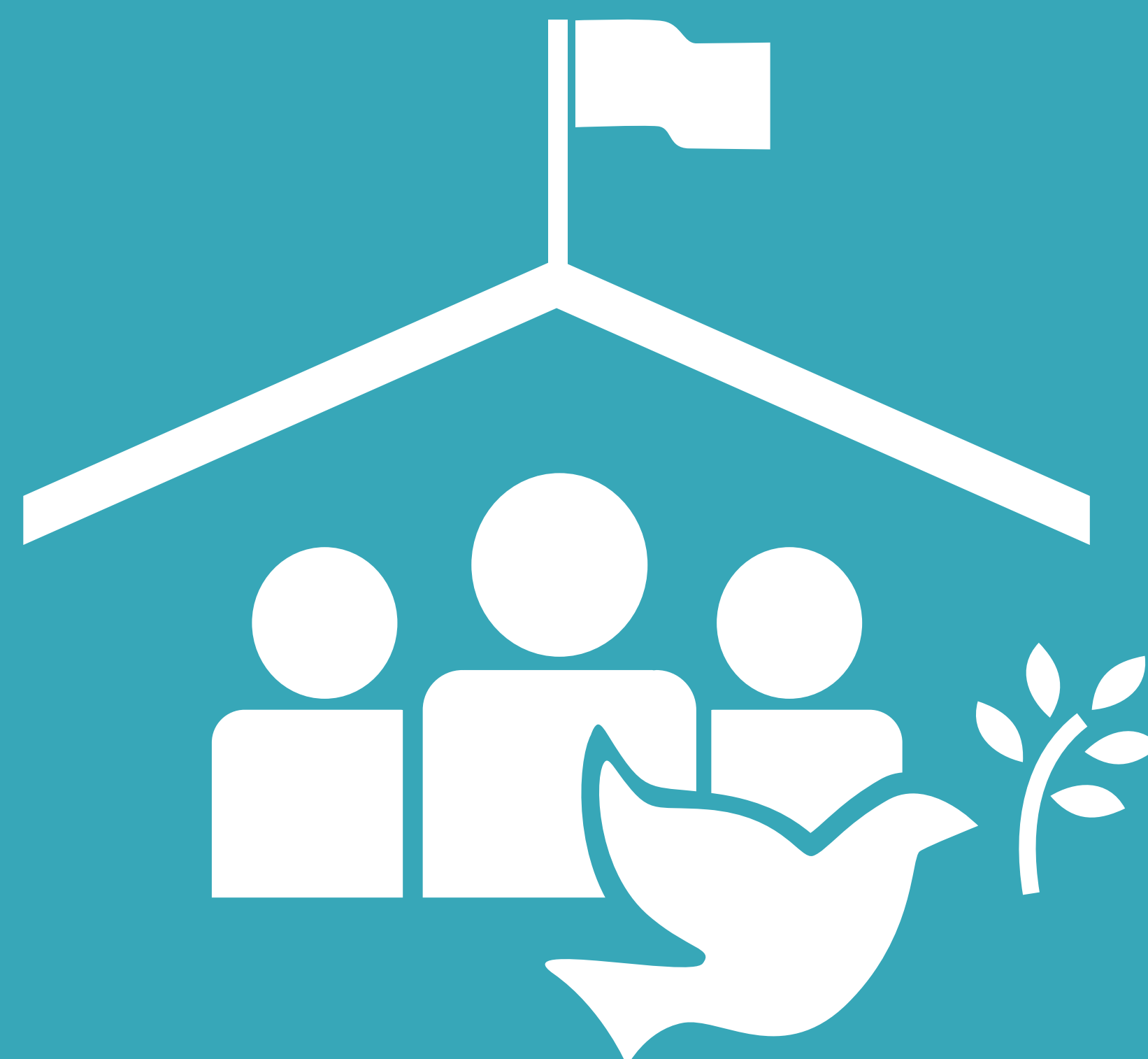

## Contributing to more open and inclusive societies

Promoting vibrant democracies, transparent public action, open civic spaces and the right to reliable information to foster inclusive public policies that work to reduce inequality.



## Strengthening the rule of law and public action

Accompanying transitions in administrations and delivering public services at all territorial levels, guaranteeing access to justice and reducing the risks of catastrophes.



## Supporting financing for sustainable development

Promoting transitions and sustainable development through better management of public finances and the mobilization of all potential investors, such as diaspora communities.



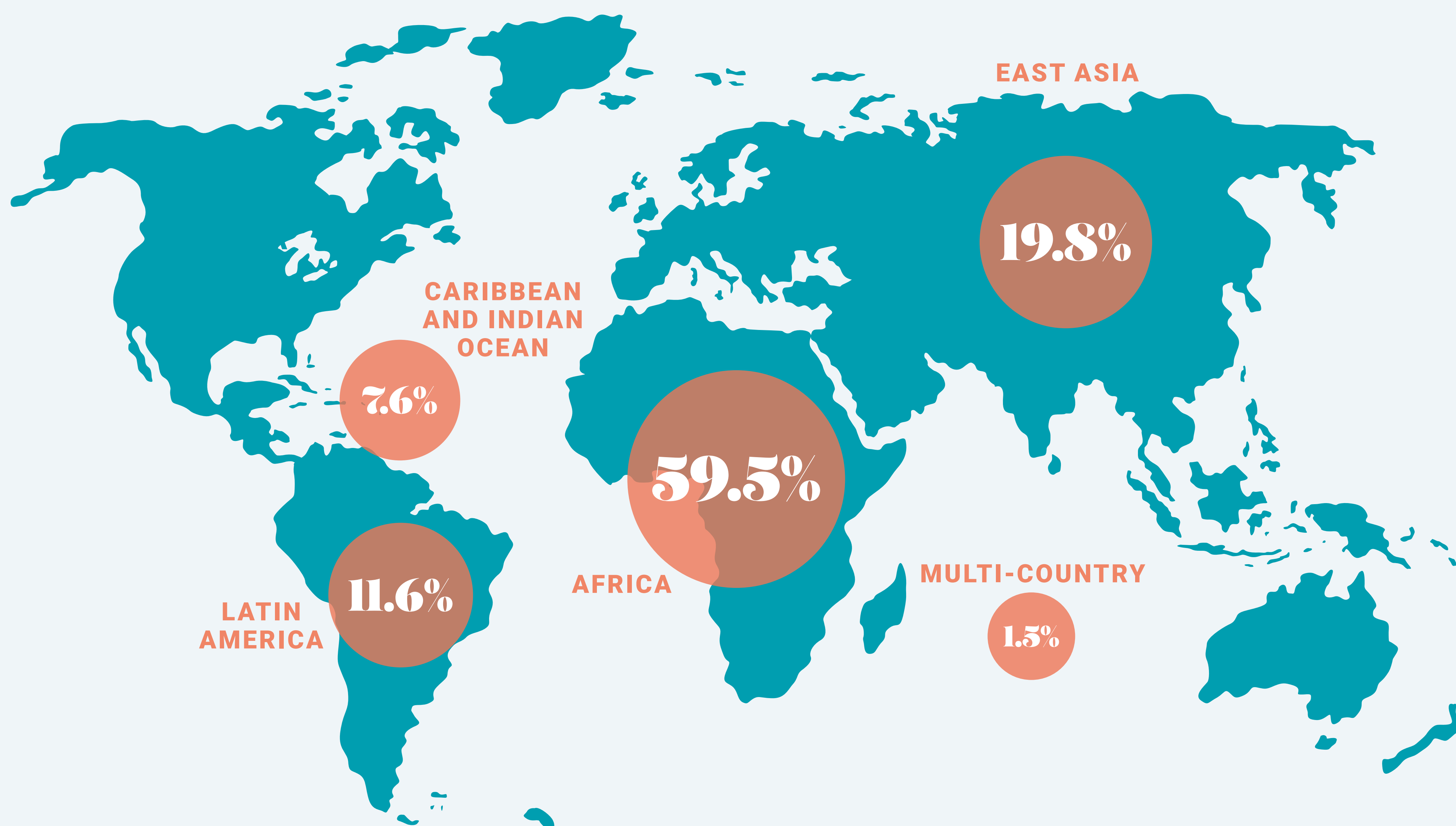
## Contributing to macroeconomic stability and crisis responses

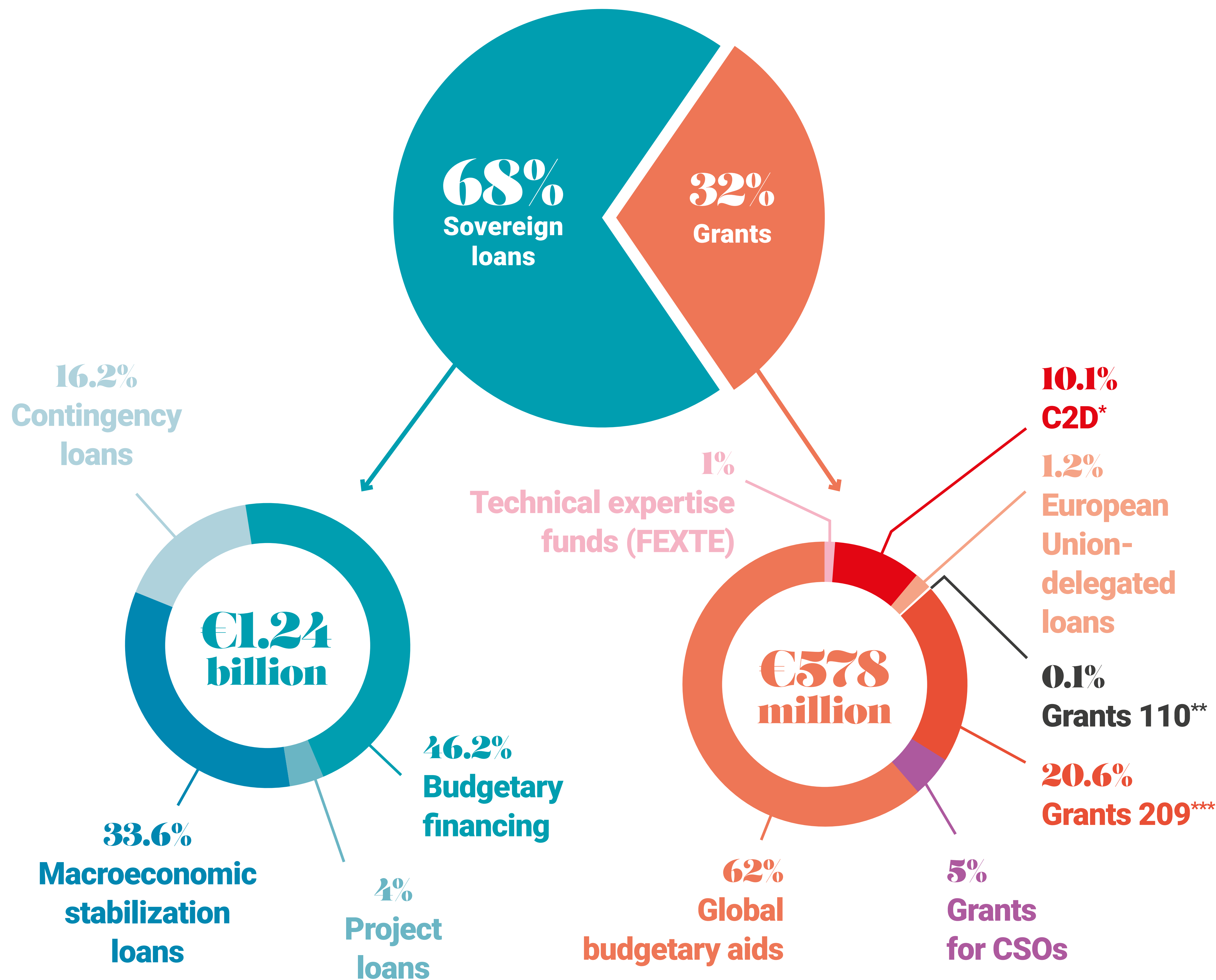

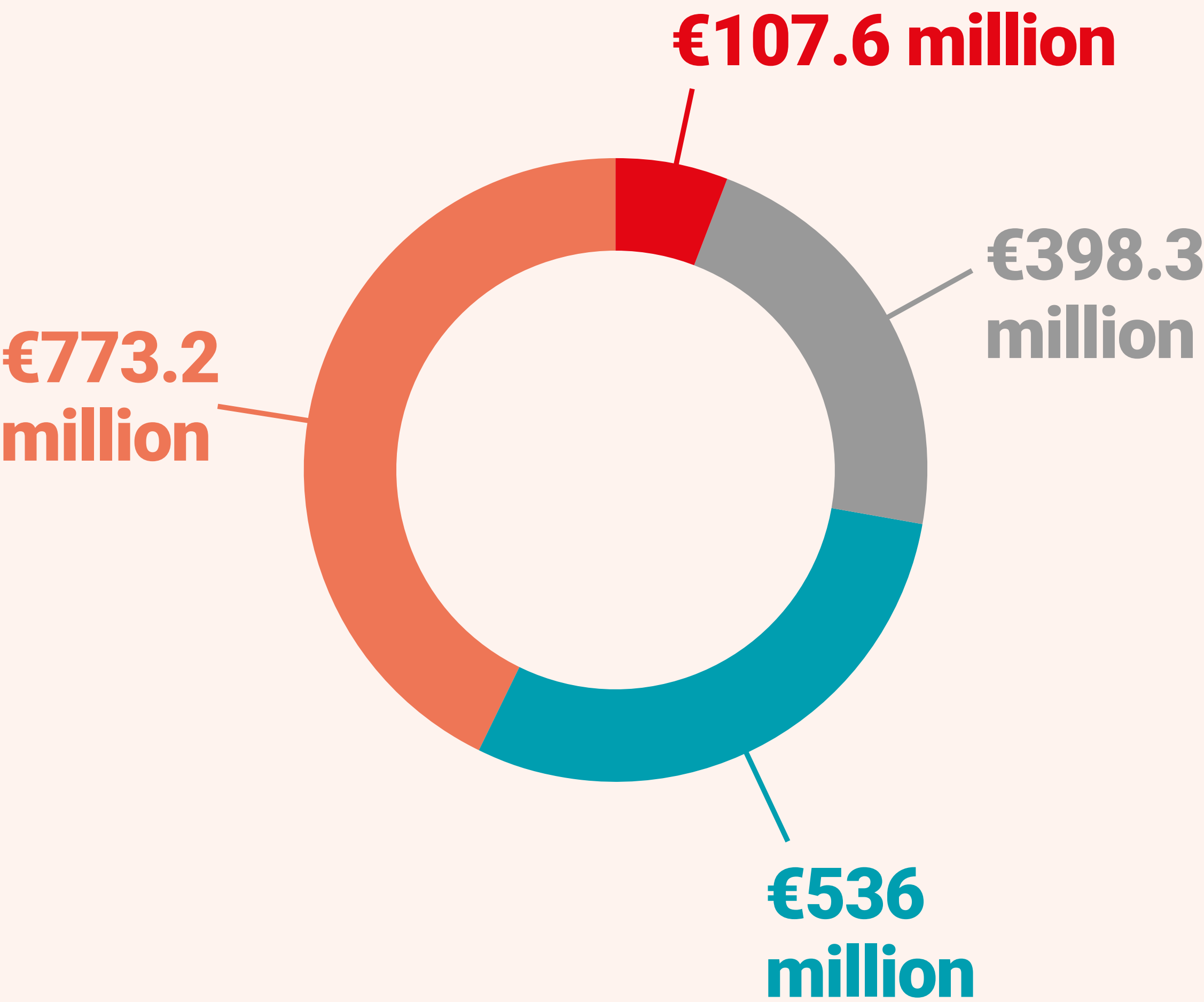

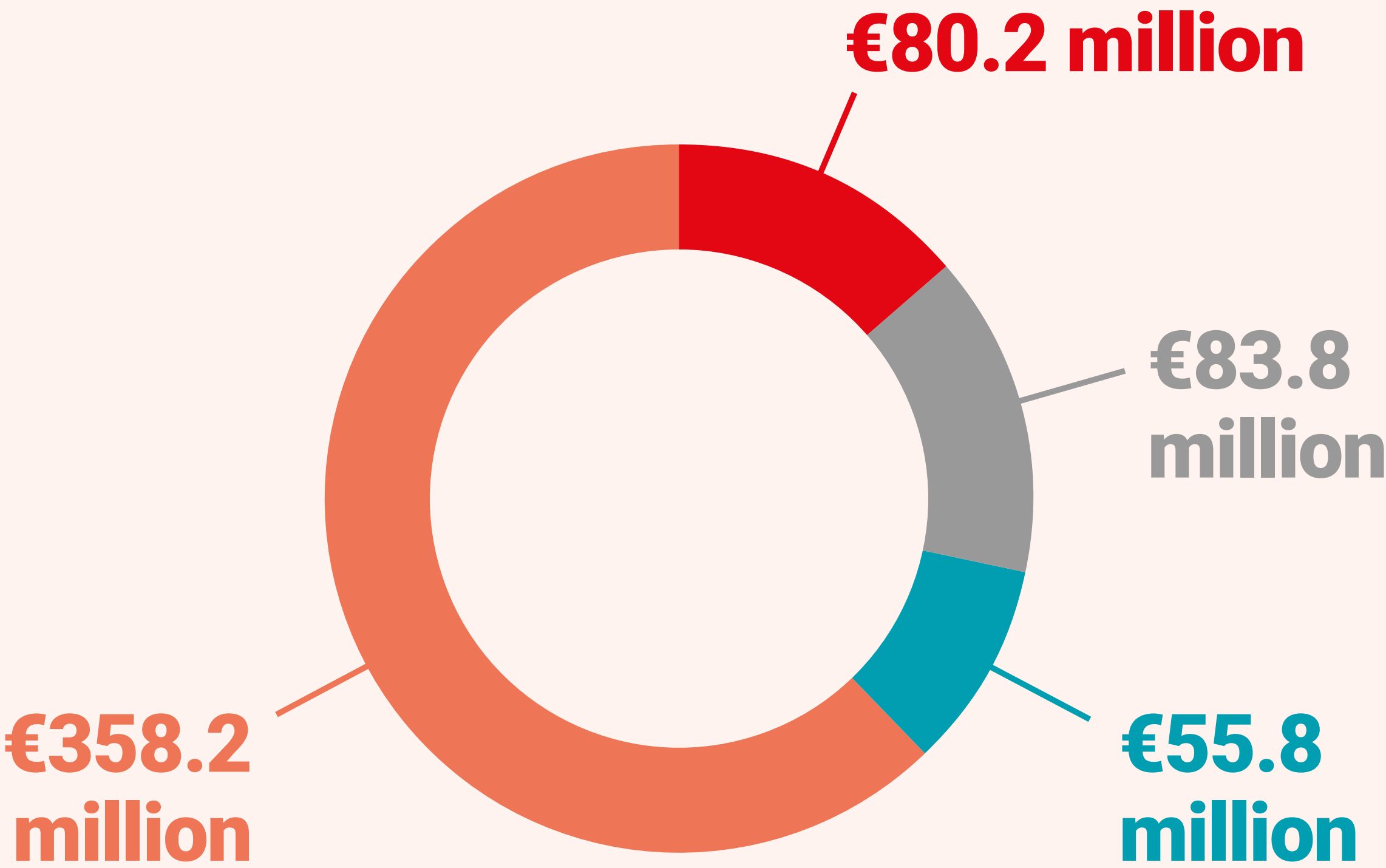

## Burundi

Bolstering the structure and framework initiatives for state and civil society dialogue

- Grants from EU delegated funds (€7 million)



## India

Reinforcement of institutional disaster management measures

- Budgetary funding in the form of loans (€80 million)
- Technical support grants (€1 million)



## Rwanda

Ecological management of public finances

- Budgetary financing in the form of loans (€50 million)
- Technical support grants (€3 million)
