

of new projects launched by Proparco in 2023 will contribute to reducing socio-economic or territorial inequalities²






Reducing inequalities in access to essential services

In 2023, AFD committed significant financing for projects aimed at improving the access of disadvantaged groups to education, vocational training, social protection, water and sanitation, energy and transport services.



BURUNDI

AFD grant: **€10 M**


Reducing economic inequalities
