# **AFD Group in the Middle East**

Established in 2019, the Middle East Regional Office (DRMO) was created to anchor and promote operational synergies among the three entities of the AFD Group, for the benefit of its clients and partners. Based in Amman, the Regional office covers four countries: Jordan, Lebanon, the Palestinian Territories, and Iraq, and ensures analytical monitoring and strategic oversight of Syria and Yemen. In these two countries, Expertise France is implementing technical assistance projects, while Proparco is active in Yemen's agri-food sector in collaboration with international stakeholders.



### STRATEGIC PILLARS OF THE GROUP'S REGIONAL ACTIVITIES

In a volatile and sensitive regional context, characterized by a high likelihood of large-scale crises and major structural challenges, the AFD Group contributes to identifying and implementing pathways toward sustainable development, to reduce vulnerabilities that threaten the future of upcoming generations. The Group has anchored its regional strategy within a ten-year timeframe (2020–2030).

With an investment portfolio exceeding €1.43 billion between 2019 and the end of 2023, the AFD Group supports states, the private sector, and non-governmental organizations by providing tailored development solutions. It deploys a wide range of financial instruments adapted to the specific needs of each partner, including loans, guarantees, and grants.

**Between 2019 and 2023, nearly 36% of AFD's commitments** focused on the water and sanitation sector, helping to expand access to clean water. In 2023 alone, 73% of AFD's commitments included climate co-benefits—demonstrating a strong response to the region's urgent challenges related to climate change and water scarcityPage.
